## Medical Information Cont:

Breeder elected not to have dewclaws removed. Not only is it torture to the 3-day old babies, but there now are studies that indicate that the removal process damages tendons that connect to muscles, resulting in carpal arthritis, improper balance andother soundness issues. Also, the dogs actually use the dewclaws to hold things, and for gripping ground in a fast turn, etc. You just need to keep them clipped if the dog doesn't wear them down.

99% of puppies have intestinal parasites and are easily transfered from mother to pup/ pup to pup. We do not quarantee against them in our puppies - we do quarantee that they will be de-wormed accordingly as listed in medical section of this outline.

## \*Puppies are not certified joint free, but have no history of hip or joint problems\*

## Puppy Feeding & Guidelines:

Weaning implemented at approximately 4 weeks - Purina Puppy Chow Healthy Morsels, blended with blender, softened/mixed with PetAq PetLac puppy milk supplement/warm water. Milk was gradually eliminated by 5 weeks and replaced with luke-warm water mixed with puppy chow.

Dry or slightly moistened with warm water puppy food began at 6 weeks until puppies were fed dry food twice daily with plenty of fresh water into the end of the 6th week.

At 7 weeks puppies are released to their new owners. It is **recommended** Purina Puppy Chow Healthy Morsels brand food be transitioned to desired feed of choice after 4 weeks. To start, mix half original brand puppy chow with desired feed of choice twice daily. As puppy transitions, stool may change consistency & color.

Follow feed label directions for amounts to provide puppy as increases in weight and age occur. Refer to labels or Veterinarian for vitamin supplements, etc.

Provide this outline/medical information to preferred veterinarian for first examination, second shot & de-worming by week 7-8

Regular worming & additional shots will be needed throughout the first year of the pups life.
